WHEREAS, Section 10.05.090 of the Staunton City Code provides that the City Manager is authorized to establish a schedule of penalties for parking violations; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager established a schedule of fines for parking violations effective on July 1, 2016, a copy of which is attached to this Executive Action.

NOW, THEREFORE, I am amending the aforementioned July 1, 2016 schedule of fines to include a \$50.00 fine for a violation of Staunton City Code Section 10.25.100.

This amendment shall be effective on November 1, 2024 after the City complies with necessary notice provisions of Staunton City Code Section 10.05.090.

SUBJECT: Parking Fines

Effective July 1, 2016, and pursuant to my authority under § 10.05.090 and Chapter 10.25 of Title 10 of the Staunton City Code, I promulgate the following schedule of fines for violations of parking restrictions applicable in the City of Staunton. References below are to sections of Staunton City Code:
