

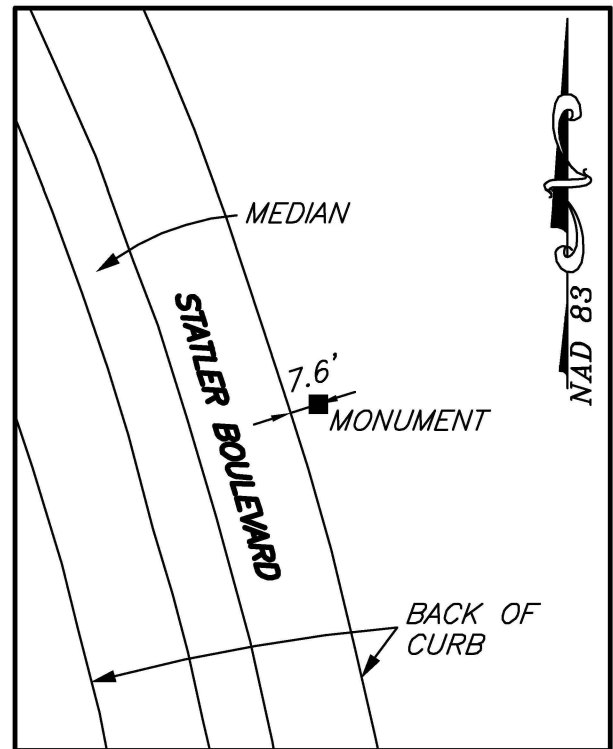

CAPPED IRON ROD SET 7.6 FEET FROM THE BACK OF CURB ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF STATLER BOULEVARD, APPROXIMATELY 1000 FEET SOUTH OF THE INTERSECTION WITH NEW HOPE ROAD AND APPROXIMATELY 225 FEET NORTH OF THE LEWIS CREEK CROSSING.
