

## **USC&G BENCHMARK MONUMENTS**

1. Monument about 0.6 Mile N. along U.S. highway 11 (by-pass) from the C&W R.R. station, along the C&W railway, on top of the E. end of the N. bridge E. of the bridge over Lewis Creek and State Rt. 254, 14' E. of the E. rail, 3' W. of the E. end of the bridge seat and about 8' below the level of the track. Elevation = 1329.108'.

2. Monument near the junction of U.S. 250 and U.S. 11 (by pass) set vertically in the N.W. concrete face of the arched C&O railway bridge over U.S. 11, 22' S.W. of the center line of the highway and 3.5' above the level of the sidewalk . Elevation = 1366.775'.

3. Monument along the C&O railway, set vertically in the S. brick face and at the S.E. corner of the C&O railway station, 1.4' W. of the S.E. corner of the station and 4.5' above the sidewalk. Elevation = 1402.386'.

4. Monument in the courthouse lawn, near the main entrance to the courthouse, 48.2' S.E. of the S. corner of the courthouse, 37' S.W. of the flagpole, 4' S.W. of a lawn shrub set in the top of a concrete post projecting 1" above the ground. Elevation = 1384.408'.

5. Monument along Englewood Dr. about 150' E. of the intersection of Churchville Ave., (U.S. Rt. 250) about 20' S. of the center line of street between lot #7, house # 1774 Englewood Dr. and parcel #3, house #1759 Churchville Ave. and set in the top of a concrete post projecting 1' above the ground. Elevation = 1396.41'.

6. Monument on top of stonewall on N.W. corner of Churchville Ave. and N. Augusta St. Elevation = 1434.025'.

7. Monument at old location of Rt. 793 (Bells Lane) crossing over C&W R.R. (1600' N. of existing crossing). 51' S.E. of centerline of track, 22' S.W. of centerline of old road, at existing fence corner, 11' W. of Vepco pole BL42, disc in top of concrete monument stamped "1374.859 B19 1929".
